Dr. Daniel J. Pugh, Sr., Ph.D. currently serves as the Vice President for Student Affairs in the Division of Student Affairs and Professor of the Practice in the Department of Educational Administration & Human Resource Development in the College of Education and Human Development at Texas A&M University.

Dr. Pugh earned a B.S. in communications and an M.S. in college student personnel from the University of Tennessee at Knoxville. His Ph.D. was awarded from the University of Georgia's Institute of Higher Education.

Prior to his arrival at Texas A&M, Dr. Pugh served as the vice provost for student affairs at the University of Arkansas. He also held appointment as associate professor of higher education in the College of Education and Health Professions' Higher Education Leadership Program.

Dr. Pugh is currently the chair-elect for and serves on the executive committee for the Council of Student Affairs in the Association of Public and Land Grant Universities (APLU).
